“Making Jewelry with the Fly Brave Foundation”

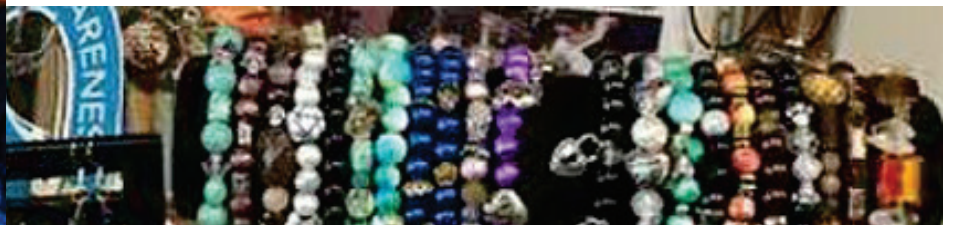
Monday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> 2017
