By leveraging technology, team members are holding <u>"Virtual Pet Therapy"</u> sessions over video calls and the results are paws-itively incredible.


Even in times of great difficulty, the smiles of our residents keep us moving forward.

Specialty Program

Eskaton Care Center Fair Oaks team members have risen to the occasion to help Eskaton fulfill its mission of enhancing the quality of life of older adults by providing essential care to those most in need of our professional services.

This week, the Care Center opened a Specialty Program for older adults in stable condition with confirmed positive COVID-19 test results. This temporary program will allow residents to recover with the assistance of healthcare professionals prior to returning home, rather than remain in the hospital.

This program is a self-contained unit with no cross-over of staff, residents and services into other areas of the center. All required protocols and precautions are being implemented to meet the needs of this vulnerable population.
